Dear Parent/Guardian:

The No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 requires that we share with you the results of your District's progress in meeting the Title III Annual Measurable Achievement Objectives (AMAOs) for English Language Learners. Districts are evaluated annually on three objectives:

1. The percentage of students who make progress in learning English
2. The percentage of students who become proficient in English
3. Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) for English Language Learners based on student test participation, graduation, attendance, and achievement in reading and math.

Districts that receive funds from the Title III program must meet all three objectives in order to meet the Annual Measurable Achievement Objectives. During 2003-04 and 2004-05, Queen Bee Schools District 16 did not meet the targets set by the State. As a result of not meeting the AMAOs for two consecutive years, the district is required to submit a District Improvement Plan by June 30, 2006 that outlines what instructional strategies will be implemented to assist the district in meeting the state targets. Once this plan is completed, it will be posted on the district website, under the link labeled **School Report Cards**.
