Who is eligible?

All children 18 years of age or under are eligible to participate in this program free of charge

Where is the program offered?

June: Americana School, 1629 President St., Glendale Heights IL 60139 (Main Entrance)

July: Glenside Middle School, 1560 Bloomingdale Rd, Glendale Heights IL 60139 (Enter DOOR 31 - near front of entrance)

What will be served?

- Breakfast: Children will receive a breakfast, this includes food options such as cereal, graham crackers, fresh fruit, juice, and milk.
- Lunch: Children will receive a lunch including a hot entrée, fruit and vegetable sides and a milk (only served June 10th–21st). A cold vegetarian option will be available daily.

IMPORTANT! Children will grab their breakfast and/or lunch and eat in the Gym (Americana)/Cafetorium (Glenside) to eat it prior to class starting. Due to federal regulations, **no food may be taken off site.**
